WHAT IS CAPTURE THE FRACTURE®?

Launched in 2012, Capture the Fracture® (CTF) guides healthcare systems in implementing **Fracture Liaison Services (FLS)**, to **improve patient care and reduce fracture-related healthcare costs** through global collaboration and best-practice sharing.







CTF Objectives

- **Evaluate** secondary fracture prevention using global standards.
- **Recognize** excellence in established FLS.
- **Guide** healthcare systems in implementing FLS.

WHAT IS A FRACTURE LIAISON SERVICE?

Post-Fracture Care (PFC) Coordination Programs, such as Fracture Liaison Services (FLS), are coordinator-based services that **strengthen care pathways and improve communication** between healthcare providers managing fragility fracture patients. They aim to close the osteoporosis care gap, as up to **80% of fracture patients** are never offered screening and/or treatment.
